

COMMUNITY WIDE ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Our new website is up! To find the live streamed events, scroll to the bottom of the front page and find the facebook symbol (a blue square with a white “F” in it) and click. MONTE VISTA

- Collections are very low currently. If you can give more, either by mail or by the Sunday Collection, please do so.
- At the end of Mass, please use the side doors and do not go into the hall. If you are meeting other family members, plan on meeting at your car, or on the sidewalks. Please maintain the six-foot distancing rule.
- Bulletins are available by the side doors.
- All who enter the parish building must register for the event at the front door. This enables us to have a tracking record in case someone falls ill with COVID-19.
- Father Don wants to advise the parish about some decisions made with regard to the tracking form and crowd management issues we have encountered..
- For the Daily Rosary, the front door will be locked at 4 pm. The rosary will be recited in the main church. Please arrive early.
- Daily Masses are to be celebrated in the main Church and employ social distancing protocols.
- All other events must start on time, and the doors are locked at the start time.
- People should arrive at least 15 minutes early to register for weekday events. Come earlier for Sunday Masses.

DEL NORTE

- At the end of Mass, please use the side aisles. maintain the 6 foot distancing rule.
- Bulletins are on the back table.

CREEDE

- At the end of Mass, please use the side aisles to leave. For those on the right side, the side door is also available. Please maintain the six-foot distancing rule.
- Bulletins are near the door in the back pew.

SOUTH FORK

- At the end of Mass, please use the side aisles to leave. Please maintain the six-foot distancing rule.
- Bulletins are at the back.

CENTER

- We had 50 people at the Spanish Mass, but only 30 at the English Mass.
- At the end of Mass, please use the side aisles. The front right side door is also available. Please maintain the six-foot distancing rule.

- Bulletins are near the doors.

SAGUACHE

- At the end of Mass, please use the side aisles to exit. Please maintain the six-foot distancing rule.
- Bulletins are at the back of the church.
